

Abstract Guidelines

An abstract is a brief, comprehensive summary of a Culminating Project. It will be placed at the front of the Culminating Project Portfolio, immediately following the Table of Contents, so that it may easily inform panelists of your overall experience. Its objective is to describe the Culminating Project, indicating the measurable result of the project at its completion.

- Minimum of 100 words
- Maximum of 1 page
- Double spaced
- Typed
- Times New Roman – size 12
- Titled
- No name necessary
- Error-Free
