

The Four Components

All students must pass each of the following four components in order to satisfy the Colville School District graduation requirements:

Product

- The Culminating Project committee must approve project.
- 15 hours minimum required.
- Mentor must verify hours, evaluate project, and complete evaluation.
- Student must show a clear challenge or learning stretch.
- Students must carefully document time, progress, and completion for three purposes: product logs; portfolio; and presentation.
- **Follow specific guidelines as outlined on page 14 in the booklet.**

Paper

- Paper must be a persuasive research paper.
- Paper will be evaluated by certified staff members.
- 5 **full** pages of text.
- 6 varied sources.
- Student must use MLA format.
- Paper must contain an arguable thesis related to hands-on product.
- Paper must be submitted to turnitin.com
- **Follow specific guidelines as outlined on page 32 in the booklet.**

Portfolio

- Use binder provided by CHS.
- Once the portfolio is submitted, a student may not add or remove items.
- Each portfolio will be evaluated by the Culminating Project committee.
- **Follow specific guidelines as outlined on page 45 in the booklet.**

Presentation

- Student is randomly assigned to a panel of community members.
- Student must be prepared to deliver speech on assigned day and time.
- Student must speak for 10-15 minutes to meet the standard.
- **Follow specific guidelines as outlined on page 47 in the booklet.**

****Students must successfully complete all four components. If a student does not meet the minimum requirement for any of the components, he/she must complete a re-do of that component.**
