3/6/08	2 hrs	<p><b>Description:</b> Used drafting skills to design layout of shed. I drafted my layout using CAD Pro software that I had learned to use last year. The program came with a basic shed design which I started with. Then I added more shelving and recalculated the wall measurements to adjust for the added shelves.</p> <p><b>Evidence:</b> A printout of the design.</p>
3/7/08	1 hr	<p><b>Description:</b> Decided where shed should be placed. Learned about landscaping and how things should be set up around the yard. Took notes on landscaping while Richard explained where would be the best place for the shed in the back yard. We also discussed possible bushes and perennials to plant around shed. Both of my parents approved of my ideas; can't wait to actually start building.</p> <p><b>Evidence:</b> Notes on landscaping and layout of backyard showing where shed will be located.</p>
3/8/08	2 hrs	<p><b>Description:</b> Cleared pad for shed and bought gravel. Was concerned that the gravel would not get delivered on time, so I borrowed a neighbor's truck and got it myself. I had never driven a loaded truck, so that was a new experience for me. The cost of the gravel was 50.00 which my parents paid for.</p> <p><b>Evidence:</b> The receipt from the purchased gravel and a picture of the pad.</p>
3/8/08	1 hr	<p><b>Description:</b> Unloaded gravel from truck and spread gravel on pad. Since I was the only one unloading the gravel it took some time. I was able to park right next to the pad for the shed which was nice so I didn't have to move the gravel.</p> <p><b>Evidence:</b> Before and after pictures of pad with gravel.</p>
3/10/08	2 hrs	<p><b>Description:</b> Bought supplies and wood from Builder's Supply and Do It Center, and unloaded wood near pad. All of the wood came from Builder's and the nails, chalk, tape, hammer and drill from Do It Center. My dad owns a saw already.</p> <p><b>Evidence:</b> Itemized receipts from stores and pictures of stacked wood.</p>
3/12/08	2 hrs	<p><b>Description:</b> Built foundation and floor following my drafted plan. The foundation actually went together fairly easily. If I go slowly and follow my plan, I don't have any problems. Plan to meet with my mentor and have him help me with the next step since I am worried about pitches and angles.</p> <p><b>Evidence:</b> Several pictures at different stages of the process.</p>
3/15/08	2 hrs	<p><b>Description:</b> Framed walls and roof with mentor's help. I am so glad that Richard was there to explain advanced construction techniques. Richard was able to fix a couple of mistakes I had made yesterday on the foundation. There was one side that was slightly raised so we took it off and refit it. Richard said that it wouldn't be noticeable until we put the roof on, but then it would be too late to go back and fix it. The shed is really coming together nicely!</p> <p><b>Evidence:</b> Several pictures at different stages of the process.</p>

3/15/08	2 hrs	<p><b>Description:</b> Continued framing walls and roof. Again I find I do okay if I take my time. Toward the end of putting the roof up I was getting tired of working with the pitches and angles. The attention to detail is sometimes too much for me.</p> <p><b>Evidence:</b> Several pictures at different stages of the process. Notes on advanced construction techniques from my mentor.</p>
3/17/08	2 hrs	<p><b>Description:</b> Today we put the siding on the frames and the roof. The shed is starting to look like the picture I had in my mind. I was able to do more of the work on my own today with Richard assisting me. At one point he had to take a phone call and I put up an entire side by myself. When Richard returned he was impressed with my work!</p> <p><b>Evidence:</b> Pictures at different stages of the process.</p>
