

Running Start Guidelines

Culminating Project requirements apply to all graduating seniors of Colville High School. Students who choose to take Running Start classes for English must still meet all requirements. This includes all deadlines. To ensure that all students are treated equitably, the following guidelines are in place for the 2009-2010 school year.

- It is the responsibility of the student to meet with a CWP teacher in order to clarify the requirements for the paper and other assignments which are due to an English teacher (see due dates page).
- Running Start students must schedule in April a practice speech time with a senior English teacher. No student will give a final speech if this has not been successfully completed.
- If a student needs assistance with any of the assignments, he/she must contact the teacher to determine a time which is acceptable and convenient for both.
- The 8:00 a.m. deadlines are for all students and are to be met regardless of whether or not the student has another obligation which conflicts with that time frame. If there is a conflict, the student needs to submit the assignment prior to the deadline.
- Culminating Project booklets are handed out in CWP class for all seniors. It is the responsibility of each student to become familiar with the requirements and due dates.
- None of the assignments for Culminating Project is class specific, but rather part of the district requirement for a common exit standard. At CHS, the assignments have been distributed among CWP and English. However, the grades received for these assignments should be a part of all students' culminating evaluation. For Running Start students, the grades received for components submitted to English classes will be compiled by the CWP teacher and become part of the final evaluation of that class.
