Sealed bids will be accepted until 2:00pm, Friday May 18, 2018, at the District Office of Colville School District No. 115. Bids will be opened at 2:01pm, May 18, 2018 and will be presented to the Board of Directors on May 23, 2018.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Inappropriately addressed envelopes may/will be opened with regular mail, rendering them unsealed and unacceptable/rejected.

ACCEPTANCE / REJECTIONS

The bid award will be on the basis determined to be in the best interest of the school district. The school district reserves the right to accept or reject bids, to waive informalities, and to contract as deemed in the best interest of the district. Successful bidder shall enter into contract within ten (10) days of written purchase authorization from the district. The award for supplying instruments will be on an "all-or-some" basis. Please bid comparable brands/models if item listed is not available.

BID QUOTATIONS

All prices must be quoted for product as specified FOB delivered as specified above. Please submit the total dollar amount of the bid and payment plan of 1 (45-day pymt), 2 or 3 years break out. The District requests the option to pay by credit card.

INVOICING

With each delivery of merchandise, the supplier is requested to leave with district personnel an itemized and priced delivery slip, which has been signed - attached.

WORK STOPPAGE

The supplier shall be responsible for and shall so conduct herself/himself as to prevent any reasonable avoidable stoppage of work by action of organized labor due to an act or admission of the supplier or his employee or agent. In the event of work stoppage, it shall be the

responsibility of the supplier to subcontract the required needs under the same terms and conditions and specification herein. Should the district be required to procure product elsewhere due to failure of the successful supplier to provide product as specified, supplier shall be liable for any additional costs incurred by the district.

NONDISCRIMINATION

The bidder agrees not to discriminate against any client, employee, or applicant for employment, because of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, marital status, age, or the presence of any sensory mental or physical handicap with regard to, but not limited to the following: Employment upgrading, demotion or transfer, recruitment or recruitment advertising, layoffs or termination, rates of pay or other forms of compensation, selection for training, and rendition of services.
