The Colville School District provides many programs for the children in our schools at no cost to you. The schools offer special programs such as Speech Therapy, Physical and Occupational Therapy, Title/LAP, and Special Education academic programs, and Preschool classes and services to children age's birth to five.

Developmental screenings and/or comprehensive assessments for children who are suspected of having a disability, which could adversely affect their educational development, are available at no cost to you. These services are available for persons between the ages of birth through 21 years of age.

School age students who are homeschooled, homeless, wards of the state, highly mobile, or migrant and reside in the district may be referred for evaluation. If eligible, they can receive services at a Seattle Public Schools site.
